This workshop will assist with assessing your potential and open opportunities for placement in events, productions and promotions and/or assistance with industry placement locally, nationally and or internationally. You may find many other opportunities to expand your contacts and connections in the myriad of associated industries. **HAVE FUN** and try something new, or simply achieve a new look and level of confidence.

The training program/workshop will be conducted at **The Quality Hotel Diplomat** on the corner Canberra Avenue and Hely Street, Manuka.

The workshop will cover such topics as;

- The business of modelling
- House modelling, manufacturing and trade showings
- Television commercials
- Photographic advertorial and editorial
- Parade and runway
- Backstage etiquette
- Model make-up
- Promotions and voice-over
- Model bag and equipment

Our workshops are extremely successful. For 22 years we have been assisting and providing top models locally, nationally and worldwide. Many international artistic crews from choreographers, stylists, make-up artists, photographers, and set, sound and fashion designers, began as students or talent with the academy and progressed through our production company, management and contacts. Recent graduates have taken part in Australian Fashion Week, international TV commercials, many national and international films, and photographic advertorial and editorial for Goldwell, KMS, CT Magazine and many national and international magazines. Our students with dance and singing abilities have been seen in national talent quests and some have been signed with record companies. Currently one of our production/event talents, who performed here in Canberra in shopping centre productions and other academy promotions, now hosts his own TV show. We are also very proud of former student models, Kylie Watson who played Shauna Bradley (Home and Away) and Lara Cox who played Anita in (Heartbreak High.) Lara completed a pilot with David E. Kelly, who is the producer of Ally McBeal and The Practice. You can see some of our students and teachers displayed on in-store posters nationally, in a Colourbond TVC, in parades at Canberra Centre, Eastlands Shopping Centre Melbourne and Westfield Miranda Sydney. The cost of the course is \$550.00 (This includes GST.) If you pay in full by the 10th of December 2009, or you have already done a course with us, the workshop will be discounted to \$480.00. You will need to bring:

- *A pair of shoes you walk in regularly (so we can assess posture)*
- *High-heeled shoes for walking classes – (smooth soled shoes for men)*
- *A bag/handbag/briefcase/gym bag (whichever you have) that could be utilised as a model bag*
- *A jacket, preferably lined (for runway classes)*
- *A notepad and pen*
- *Any make-up that you use (even the junk at the bottom of your draw or cupboard.) We also have a full range if you do not have any products.*
- *Any skin care products that you use.*
- *Changes of clothing for backstage and fast changing techniques. (This doesn't have to be a fashion statement; it is simply for change time.)*
- *Something you would like to be photographed in. The shoot will be on Sunday at 12pm. The sitting fee is \$30.00 and is to be paid directly to the photographer.*

KEY: ALL SATURDAY CLASS REQUIREMENTS

At the Academy we prefer you do not buy anything new for the course, but utilise what you already have at home. Should you wish to purchase anything, we suggest you discuss it with the teachers to ensure value for money and an appropriate purchase. There will be no restaurant facilities available during the workshop; therefore you may wish to bring snacks, lunch and a drink each day.

We are always looking for new talent, successfully trained. Please call as soon as possible to confirm your attendance. This program is very popular and fills very quickly. We would like to have numbers finalised ASAP so we can prepare appropriate course material, tutors and trainers etc.
